| Ratio and Group Size | 1-5 points are awarded based on the average adult/child ratio and group size in each classroom. Highest points are awarded to classrooms with small group sizes and more adults per child | ★★★★☆ |
| Program Environment | 1-5 points are awarded based on assessment scores using a tool that measures health and safety, quality of materials, room arrangement, schedules, and interactions in the classroom and program | ★★★★☆ |
| Director Qualifications | 1-5 points are awarded based on the director’s professional development and formal education. Highest points are awarded to directors who hold an Administrative Credential or Master’s degree | ★★★★★ |
